* The program rules allow only one grant to be awarded to a government until all other eligible applicants have been awarded during the funding cycle. The following entities submitted multiple applications for FY 2009-2010. When projects are moved to the bottom of the list, they are listed by score, from high to low.

- Miami-Dade County submitted three applications. The Arcola Lakes Branch is ranked higher based on score.
- Both Alachua County Library District projects received the same score. The district has chosen to rank the Millhopper Branch Library project higher.
- Broward County submitted four applications. Two projects received the same score. The county has chosen to rank the Lauderhill Central Park Branch Library project higher.

** Gilchrist, Hamilton, and Suwannee counties; Polk City; and the City of Apalachicola received a waiver of the program's matching requirement as allowed under s. 257.191, *F.S.* and s. 288.06561, *F.S.* (Rural Economic Development Initiative).
