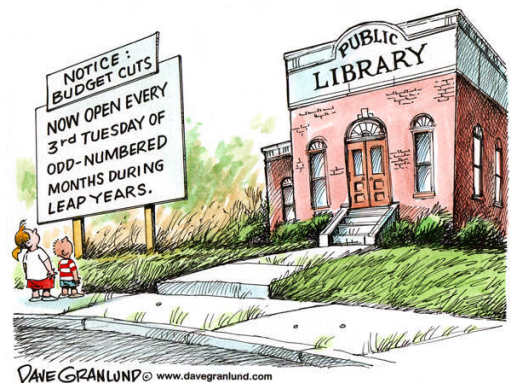


The Changing Library:

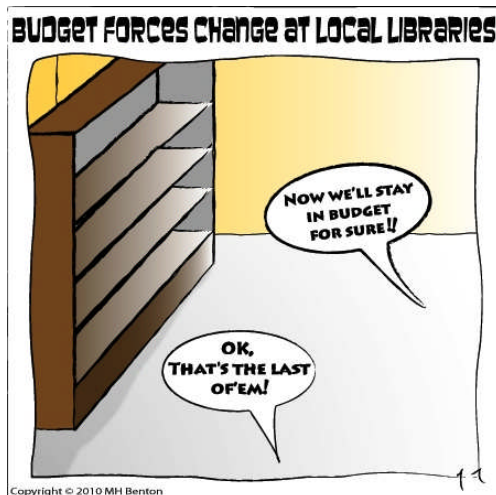
